In the last decade three of polar history's most famous wrecks have been discovered. Distinguished explorers and bestselling authors John Geiger and Mensun Bound will present the sensational discoveries of John Franklin's *HMS Erebus* and Ernest Shackleton's *Endurance*.



Mensun Bound

is a Fellow of the Royal Geographical Society and Explorer's Club. Known as 'Indiana Jones of the Deep,' Bound has conducted wreck surveys and excavations all over the world in a career that spanned over 40 years.

In 2019 and 2022 Bound was Director of Exploration for the search to find Shackleton's *Endurance* in Antarctica. On 5 March 2022 the *Endurance* was found at a depth of 3000 meters under the ice.

His journey to find the lost ship of Sir Ernest Shackleton's Imperial Trans-Antarctic Expedition is chronicled in his latest book, *The Ship Beneath the Ice: The Discovery of Shackleton's Endurance*.



John Geiger, CM

is the international bestselling author of seven books, including *Frozen in Time: The Fate of the Franklin Expedition*, and *The Third Man Factor: Surviving the Impossible*. His work has been translated into fourteen languages.

The chief executive officer of the Royal Canadian Geographical Society, Geiger graduated in history from the University of Alberta and holds an honorary Doctor of Laws from the University of Calgary. He is recipient of both the Polar Medal and the Order of Canada and co-author of *Franklin's Lost Ship: The Historic Discovery of HMS Erebus*.
